1 PURPOSE

This report details the consultation undertaken by Ferrovial Gamuda Joint Venture (FGJV) to obtain community agreement for out of hours (OOH) for earthworks at Englands Rd and Isles drive from 6:00PM to 10:00PM Monday to Friday, and 1:00PM to 10:00PM Saturdays. The agreement period is up to July 2025.

This report has been prepared in accordance with EPL Condition E1.3 as detailed in Table 1 below.

2 PROPOSED OOHW

In accordance with EPL Condition E1, FGJV has sought community agreement from noise sensitive receivers to work outside of approved construction hours on Englands Road and Isles Drive between the following hours where required to reduce the program of work by four weeks:

- 6:00PM to 10:00PM Monday to Friday, and/or
- 1:00PM to 10:00PM Saturdays

Activities associated with the proposed works include:

- Construction of foundation, UZF and SMZ, HB
- Seal.
- Concrete pavement & footpath pours,
- Barrier shifts
- Subsoil installation
- Kerb installation
- AC placement
- Linemarking

2.1 JUSTIFICATION

In this instance, works within the nominated area are impacted by interactions with local businesses and ROL restrictions. To date, this has caused delays in the projects program, as works can only be completed out of business hours.

The extended working hours at Englands Rd and Isles Drive will allow for project works to take place on weekdays, after business hours. This will prevent program critical activities from being delayed.

3 NOISE SENSITIVE RECEIVERS

A detailed noise impact assessment of all proposed works was undertaken using the Project's Noise Model Noisecheck to identify noise sensitive receivers predicted to experience noise levels above the daytime OOH noise management level (NML) and agreement would need to be sought from. A copy of the Noise Assessment Reports is included in Attachment A.

Several residential receivers shown in the Noisecheck report contained in Attachment A have been removed from the receiver list given they have been either demolished, not built yet (e.g. future Elements Estate development) or are not residential properties following ground truthing.

Following this ground truthing exercise, a total of 63 residential and 1 medical centre receivers were identified as noise affected for the proposed OOH construction on Englands Road and Isles Drive, and agreement was sought from them.

Predicted noise impacts are summarised in Table 2 and a more detailed breakdown at each receiver address is provided in Attachment B.

4 CONSULTATION SUMMARY

All 64 noise sensitive receivers were emailed and/or letterbox dropped a copy of the letter detailing the Project's request for community agreement as a first attempt to make contact (refer to Attachment C). This written agreement also formed the script used during the consultation and included the following details:

- Description of the different construction activities proposed consistent with Section 2 above;
- Proposal for OOH construction on Englands Rod and Isles Drive between 6:00PM and 10:00PM
 Monday to Friday, and 1:00PM to 10:00PM Saturdays where required
- Map showing the location of the proposed work;
- Summary of the noise levels predicted consistent with Section 3 above;
- List of plant and equipment to be used for the work;
- Mitigation measures to minimise impacts;
- Receiver's ability to withdraw agreement at any stage during the work;
- Ongoing consultation process to ensure continuation of agreement throughout the program of work;
- Other out of hours work in the area;
- Project contact details.

Follow up phone calls, emails and door knocks were also made in second and third attempts to contact all residents.

Where a doorknock was made and the resident was not home, a sorry we missed you card was left asking the resident to get in contact with the Project Team to discuss the community agreement.

The letter requesting consideration of the proposal expressed that a non-response would be considered as agreement to the project's proposed works.

5 COMMUNITY RESPONSE & CONSENT RATES

During the consultation period, the FGJV Community team made contact with 33 percent of the noise sensitive receivers (20 residents). Despite three attempts to make contact using a range of communication methods, 67 percent did not formally respond (44 residents). As detailed in the agreement letter in Attachment C, a non-response is considered to be agreement to the proposal.

As detailed in Table 3, formal agreement to undertake proposed OOH for evenings Monday – Saturday was 29.7 percent of receivers, and 1.5 percent did not agree. Of the 64 impacted receivers who did formally respond (20 receivers), <u>95%</u> of residents did provide their agreement which constitutes a substantial majority.

Copies of the signed agreements will be submitted to the EPA along with this report.

A more detailed breakdown of the consultation undertaken with each receiver and their response is provided in Attachment B.

Re: Agreement to work outside of approved construction hours on Englands Road and Isles Drive for the Coffs Harbour bypass

The Australian and NSW Governments are investing in the 14-kilometre Coffs Harbour bypass project. The bypass will boost the regional economy and improve connectivity, road transport efficiency and safety for all motorists.

As part of major construction, the project will soon be moving traffic into different lanes to allow construction to continue in this area. These traffic changes will include:

- Highway northbound motorists moving onto the new western service road lanes
- Highway southbound motorists moving onto the existing highway northbound lanes
- Building of a temporary roundabout south-west of the current Pacific Highway and Englands Road intersection.

Once we have completed these traffic changes, the project will be building at the current Pacific Highway and Englands Road intersection and on the existing highway southbound carriageway.

To reduce the duration of this work needed to make the upcoming traffic changes by four weeks, we are seeking your agreement to extend our construction hours between **Monday and Friday from 6pm to 10pm** and on **Saturdays from 7am to 8am and 1pm to 10pm until July 2025.**

Our project's approved construction hours are Monday to Friday between 7am and 6pm, and Saturdays between 8am and 1pm.

The activities covered in this proposed agreement are foundation and earthworks, relocating concrete barriers, laying new pavements (including asphalt and concrete), installing kerb and line-marking.

Under the project's Ministerial Conditions of Approval, the team can work two nights and then provide a night of respite. We can also seek agreement from noise impacted community members to not provide respite and work outside of approved construction hours. The project is required to have agreement from a substantial majority to progress with these activities.

Noise levels


Equipment to be used for this work will include light and heavy vehicles, excavators, cranes, tipper trucks, vac truck, smooth drum roller, pad foot roller, grader, vibration plate, concrete vibrator, kerb and barrier paving machine, road profiler, line-marker, concrete trucks and pump, asphalt paver, water carts, rigid body trucks, spray seal truck, semi-trailers and traffic control vehicles within the project boundary.

We have assessed the environmental impacts of this work, and it will only result in changes to noise levels. The predicted noise levels are expected to be quiet to moderate. We have provided an illustration of comparative noise levels on the next page. This work should not be overly intrusive to your outdoor amenity.

To ensure compliance and mitigate impacts of this work, we will:

- Consult with directly impacted residents ahead of the work starting and during work
- Monitor noise levels, dust and vibration
- Turn off plant and machinery when not in use
- Position plant and equipment as far from nearby neighbours as possible.


